The Small Print

- Minimum bids are allowed (and expected) on any “big ticket” items, such as vehicles.
- For all items sold in the auction, 10% of the bid price, which is paid by the SELLER, goes to the SEVTR Committee (SEVTR). Figure that in when deciding on a minimum reserve bid.
If the BUYER pays by check, the check will be made out for the full amount to the SELLER. Then the SELLER pays the 10% fee to (SEVTR).
- No charge for items registered but not sold.
- Of course, donation of auction items to the (SEVTR) will be appreciated.
- Sellers may enter cars to be sold in the Show (Show registration fee is required). Identify them as being offered for auction.

Transport, storage and handling of all items to be auctioned are the responsibility of the SELLER (before/during the auction) or the BUYER (after the auction). The Days Inn and the Southeast Vintage Triumph Registry Committee (SEVTR) will not be responsible for damage, loss or theft.
